

# TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN CLASS

Our Transitional Kindergarten is meant to be a bridge between Pre-K (4's) and Kindergarten. The fall semester will review information presented in Pre-K and the spring semester will introduce concepts from kindergarten. Students in this class will be expected to write in their journal and start to read early readers.

**Curriculum: Frog Street Pre-K (TEA approved for Pre-K Guidelines), Scholastic Weekly Reader, and Scholastic Leveled Readers (A-D).**

## **Learning Goals:**

- Identify capital and lower case letters
- Identify letter sounds
- Identifies numbers 0 to 9
- Uses addition and subtraction skills
- Count objects
- Understands ordinal terms like "second"
- Uses some appropriate writing rules
- Recognize and write full name independently
- Identify rhyming words
- Identify opposites
- Identify and continue AB and ABB patterns
- Child can retell or reenacts a story after it is read aloud
- Child can asks and answer appropriate questions about books
- Gross motor skills of hopping on one foot, galloping and jumping
- Manipulates syllables of words
